## ORION GALA DINNER

### **Introduction:**

The Orion Organisation in Atlantis, Western Cape is a therapeutic and training centre for children and adults with mental, physical and intellectual disabilities.

Orion's main objective is not only to become the most preferred centre for people with disabilities but also to be a true model of inspiration and motivation to other similar organisations in the Western Cape.

We are a registered Non-Profit Organisation with PBO Status.

### **Projects:**

Orion comprises the Wilge Special Day Care Centre for disabled children between the ages of 18 months and 18 years, group housing for 60 adults, including a semi-frail care unit, an Activity Day Care Centre for profoundly disabled adults, two labour work centres which serve as income generating projects, and a bakery where training is offered.

Trainees are empowered with contract work from the automotive and textile industries in South Africa. This includes the assembly of accessories, the recycling of hangers for clothes, the weighing/packaging of food ingredients and the cutting/mounting of fibreglass components for electrical conductors.

Through these efforts, Orion has in recent years successfully trained and deployed 30 disabled people in the open labour market, with 2 more placements to follow within the next month.

### **Funding**

Although Orion is working towards becoming self-sustainable, we still rely on the following to as an income:

- 25% through state subsidies
- 25% through income generating projects
- 50% through fundraising initiatives

## Objective of the Gala Dinner

Many organisations, institutions, companies/ businesses, trusts, etc still do not consider giving **funds towards operational costs**. However it is not possible to care for 200 children and adults on a voluntary basis and without professional staff on board. It is for this reason that the organisation initiated a gala dinner and other initiatives to contribute/ cover this huge expenditure.

This year the event will be hosted at the **Southern Sun, Cape Town** on **13 November 2010**.
